Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to a petition 1013-08 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by the Honourable Andrew Fraser MP, Treasurer, Member for Mount Coot-tha on 15 April 2008 regarding an afternoon direct school bus service from Gregory Terrace, Spring Hill to The Gap/Ashgrove/Bardon/Red Hill areas and a direct morning and afternoon bus service for students attending All Hallows' School.

The Queensland Government's priority for school service funding is to enable students to travel to the nearest state school. Regrettably, the Queensland Government is unable to fund direct services to all facilities, schools or destinations.

In line with Queensland Transport's school transport policy, services beyond the nearest state school are discretionary and based on the viability of the service. Funding for school services is extremely tight and, unfortunately, there is no funding currently available to provide the direct school services requested by the Petitioners.

Currently, the Queensland Government subsidises student travel to approximately \$150 million per annum. The choice to attend other than the local school is supported. However, it must be assumed that parents consider available transport when choosing a school for their children.

I am advised that there are currently a number of services available for students travelling from the western suburbs to schools along Gregory Terrace and Ann Street as shown below.
