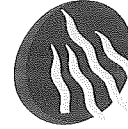

Thank you for your letter of 29 November 2010 about petition No.1563-10 received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly.

The petition concerns the proposed use of a section of Anzac Park, Toowong, as off-street parking for workers of the Brisbane City Council's Legacy Way project (formerly the Northern Link Road Tunnel project).

The proposal was part of an assessment of project changes for the Legacy Way, which was undertaken by the Coordinator-General pursuant to Part 4 Division 3A of the *State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971*. The Department of Infrastructure and Planning coordinated the assessment process on behalf of the Coordinator-General. A copy of the petition was provided to the department for information.

On 17 December 2010, the Coordinator-General finalised assessment of the proposed project changes. In the Coordinator-General's report, the Coordinator-General refused the proposal to locate workforce parking within a section of Anzac Park. It was recommended the proponent review the project's workforce parking strategy and consider existing parking areas in the vicinity of the project site.
