Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to petition numbers 3002-18 and 2965-18 lodged with the Legislative Assembly on 4 September 2018, requesting a Bruce Highway northbound entry ramp and southbound exit ramp at Dohles Rocks Road.

The Dohles Rocks Road interchange, including entry and exit ramps, is being considered as part of an \$8 million planning project that is nearing completion. This planning is expected to be completed later this year and is jointly funded with the Australian and Queensland Governments. The outcomes of the planning project will assist in prioritising the allocation of funding for future upgrades on the Bruce Highway between Pine River and Caloundra Road, including the requirements for the Dohles Rocks Road interchange.

Improvements were completed in August 2018 to upgrade the Dohles Rocks Road intersection with the existing Bruce Highway entry and exit ramps. Those works were jointly-funded between the Australian Government, Queensland Government and Moreton Bay Regional Council, to improve traffic flow and safety at this location.

I trust this information is of assistance.
