Thank you for your letter of 13 October 2023 regarding Petition Number 3959-23 received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly concerning native timber harvesting at Deongwar State Forest.

Selective native timber harvesting operations in Queensland's State forests must be undertaken in accordance with a wide range of due diligence and compliance requirements, including meeting the *Code of practice for native forest timber production on Queensland's state forest estate 2020* (the Code). The Code is administered and overseen by the Department of Environment and Science.

The Code contains specific protection measures for hollow-dependant fauna, including standard requirements for the retention of habitat and recruitment trees. These requirements reflect the recommendations of the Habitat Tree Technical Advisory Group outlined in the *Managing Habitat Trees in Queensland Forests* report (Lamb et al. 1998).

Under the Native Timber Action Plan, the Queensland Government has committed to ending native timber harvesting in state forests in the South East Queensland Regional Plan area by 31 December 2024, including the Deongwar State Forest.

I trust this information is of assistance to the petitioners.
