Dear Mr Laurie

Thank you for your letter dated 26 April 2006 in relation to Petition No. 644-06 received by the Legislative Assembly on 21 April 2006 concerning the deaths of Mrs Vicki Arnold and Julie-Anne Leahy.

I have been informed that inquests have been held on two previous occasions where findings were handed down, firstly, on 3 September 1992 and then, secondly, on 21 February 2000.

As the deaths occurred prior to the proclamation of the *Coroners Act 2003*, your request for assistance must be dealt with under the *Coroners Act 1958*. Under section 47 of that Act, I have the statutory power to direct that an inquest be reopened if I am satisfied it is necessary given the particular circumstances of each matter.

I advise that I am currently considering all the recent allegations that have been raised surrounding the circumstances of Vicki Arnold's and Julie-Anne Leahy's deaths.

I undertake to advise you of my decision on whether the inquest will be reopened when I have finalised my deliberations.

Thank you for bringing this matter to my attention.
