Dear Mr Laurie

Thank you for your letters dated 11 and 31 May 2006 concerning petitions lodged with the Queensland Legislative Assembly on 10 and 26 May 2006 numbered 649-06 and 661-06 regarding proposed changes to the religious instruction provisions under the Education (General Provisions) Bill 2006 introduced into the Queensland Parliament on 21 April 2006.

I would like to make it clear that our government strongly supports religious instruction and guarantees its place in schools.

The feedback I have received indicates there are concerns in the community about the proposed changes to the religious instruction provisions. Accordingly, the government has decided not to proceed with the amendments. The status quo will remain.

The existing arrangements regarding religious instruction in state schools have been in place for some time and have not brought significant objections from either parents or the general community.

Thank you for bringing your views on this matter to my attention. I trust this information now clarifies the situation for you and reaffirms the government's commitment to the provision of religious instruction in our state schools.
