I refer to a petition lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mrs Dorothy Pratt MP, Member for Nanango, requesting a 40km/h school zone on the D'Aguilar Highway directly in front of Woodford State School.

I have been advised that officers from the Department of Main Roads have completed an assessment for a 40km/h school zone in this area and support its implementation near Woodford State School.

I am further advised that Main Roads have presented this recommendation to the Caboolture Speed Management Committee which endorsed the recommendation at the meeting of 22 August 2007. This committee includes representatives from Queensland Transport, Main Roads, Queensland Police Service and Caboolture Shire Council.

Main Roads will hold discussions with representatives from Woodford State School to finalise timeframes and implementation details. It is anticipated this process will be completed by mid-October 2007.
